## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION/RENEWAL

The EH Holden Car Club of WA was formed after the bi-annual All GM Owners Day in November 1990.

The club was initially formed with a large group of genuine and sincere enthusiasts and restorers from all age groups, both male and female.

Collectively these members have a wide variety of experience and knowledge and offer assistance to owners or restorers where ever practical.

A regular bi-monthly newsletter is printed containing general club news, a program of meetings – events – car shows – garage scene – memorabilia articles – technical articles and advertisements. A free classified section containing vehicles, parts, panels and accessories either for sale, swap or wanted to buy etc.

An attractive car window sticker, membership card and a copy of the constitution is issued to new members. Trade discounts on parts & services are available from a number of automotive outlets.

A reciprocal newsletter exchange is run with a number of other Holden clubs through out Australia & New Zealand and these are available at meetings for members to read, if they wish.

Although there are a large number of motor shows and events held by a variety of car clubs & other organisations, which members may wish to enter and attend. The club officially enters a select few events to promote the club and the EH Holden, which are generally subsidised for members entering.

Additionally the club organises outings where members may collectively use their vehicles for mutual enjoyment and driving pleasure. At times general meetings may be combined with an organised club run.

The club is a member of the Council of Motoring Clubs of WA Inc., a body set up to represent the interests of motoring enthusiasts, who regularly liase with various organisations such as the RAC, Department of Transport and the Government of WA who legislate and regulate the use of vehicles in WA.

The club is run by a management committee consisting of President, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor and Events Co-ordinator. The Technical Committee oversee the Concessional Licensing of club vehicles. All other members are encouraged to associate, participate and support the club meetings or events as may be practical to their personal circumstances.

Membership is **NOT** transferable. The membership categories are:-

**Full Member:** Available to anyone owning a presentable & acceptable registered EH Holden or possessing one under construction or restoration. Either original GMH factory condition or modified.

Note: Modified vehicles must be legally registered.

**Associate Member:** Available to enthusiasts who are non vehicle owners, non WA residents or owners of un-registered vehicles including Appendix J racecars who possess a keen interest for the Statement of Purpose and Objectives of the club.

**Membership Fees:** Annual subscription fee of **\$60.00**
